

PVC Pipe Laying

(This course aligns to the Water Corporation requirements for PVC Pipe Laying)

About this Course

The PVC Pipe Laying course is required by the Water Corporation of WA. This course will provide participants with the knowledge and the skills to understand different types of PVC pipe and their properties, the correct excavation requirements; including the relevant safety and installation methods that conform to the utility provider's specifications.

This course is delivered and assessed face to face. There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

Refreshers are required every three (3) years.

- Must have a USI Number (www.usi.gov.au)
- Competent in Reading, Writing and speaking English

- Pipe identification and marking
- Physical properties
- Storage, uploading and handling
- Excavation precautions and regulations
- Soil conditions, fill and pipe support zones
- Thrust blocks
- Cutting and chamfering
- Solvent cement joining installation
- Rubber ring jointing
- Tapping methods
- Pipeline repairs
- Testing and commissioning
