

Restricted Gas Assessment for G Class Permit

About this Course

A trainee must hold a restricted Permit (training permit), enabling them to perform gasfitting work while working under supervision, prior to undertaking gasfitting training at the Certificate III or IV level. The Permit must be endorsed for the class or type of gasfitting work being undertaken.

To obtain a training permit, the applicant must have successfully completed basic training and assessment on the following:

- WA gasfitting legislation and appropriate industry standards – key elements
- Gas safety principles
- Combustion, flueing and exhaust principles

Pre Requisites

****You must upload your Pre Requisites when you enrol online. You will upload the information under “supporting documents” We will not accept your enrolment without it.**

- Must be a qualified plumber with a Plumbing Trades License
- Must have a USI Number (www.usi.gov.au)

There are 3 categories

1. **within 2 years** – a permit can be issued by Building and Energy on receipt of the application. You will not need to attend the Restricted Gas Assessment
2. **between 2 and 5 years** – the person is required to complete successfully theory Assessment for:
 - A. Gas Standards Legislation
 - B. Gas Safety, Basic Combustion & Flueing
 - C. AS/NZ5601
3. **more than 5 years or New Applicant** – the person is required to complete successfully a theory and practical assessment for:
 - A. Gas Standards Legislation
 - B. Gas Safety, Basic Combustion & Flueing
 - C. *Not Required*
 - D. Undertake training for the CPC32713 Certificate III in Gasfitting.

MPA Skills deliver the CPC32713 Certificate III in Gasfitting, please see our website for course dates

On successful completion of the Restricted Gas Assessment, students are to apply to Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety - Building and Energy for their permit (applications can take up to 4 weeks for approval). If you are in Category 3 and are wanting to enrol into the Certificate III in Gas, you must have your G Class Permit so please allow time for processing.
