


CONSTRUCTION TRAINING FUND (CTF)

The program gives participants the opportunity to try different trades, find the right career path and learn critical skills needed for the job. Participants gain real-world experience through practical activities led by an experienced professional. Each Try-A-Trade course runs for up to three days and focuses on two to three trades.

As it is funded by the CTF there is no cost to schools, but you do have to register via the link below. Select Trade Stream and in the free typing section at the bottom, ask for painting and plumbing.

PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS AND APPRENTICESHIPS

A pre-apprenticeship provides a true insight into the plumbing or painting industries. It is the first step to potentially gaining an apprenticeship. There are two ways young people can undertake a pre-apprenticeship, either school-based or full-time.

SCHOOL-BASED PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS

These are available at partner schools across the metropolitan area and involve students in Years 11 and / or 12 attending our class once a week during terms one to three, where they receive a mix of theory and practical instruction. During this time students are required to undertake work experience which MPA Skills can arrange through our specialist network of host companies.

FULL-TIME PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS

These run full-time at our campuses for 10 weeks which includes four weeks of work experience, which MPA Skills can facilitate through our specialist network of host employers.

Both full-time and school-based pre-apprenticeships are accredited towards the full apprenticeship which means students don't have to repeat their learning.

APPRENTICESHIPS

An apprenticeship is a four-year practical, handson training program where students are paid while they learn. As an apprentice, students are contracted to an employer to learn all about their chosen trade. The apprenticeship is a combination of on-the-job practical training and off-thejob structured training at a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) such as MPA Skills.

MPA Skills is considered by many to be the best industry apprenticeship program for plumbing or painting. As a Group Training Organisation as well as being an RTO, we also employ hundreds of apprentices ourselves and place these apprentices with the best host employers so we can ensure as varied, safe and dynamic on the job learning experience for apprentices as possible.

As the employer, we pay for training, PPE, professional development and each apprentice is assigned their own Field Officer who checks in with apprentices over the phone and onsite to monitor their progress.
