

52915WA Course in Migrant Plumbing

About this Course

Australia has strict safety standards and licensing requirements associated with licensed trades. In order to carry out plumbing work in Western Australia a person must hold the appropriate licence issued by the Plumbers Licensing Board in Western Australia (PLB). https://www.commerce.wa.gov.au/building-and-energy/plumbing-tradespersons-licence
Plumbers who were trained outside Australia are required to demonstrate they have the skills and knowledge necessary to be granted a licence. In Western Australia, the standard applied to assess the skills and knowledge to meet the requirements of this course.

52915WA Course in Migrant Plumbing, has been developed specifically to address particular gaps in plumbing from overseas applicants to ensure that Australian Standards are understood using a blend of theory and practical tasks. This course has been approved by the Plumbing Licencing Board as a requirement for obtaining a tradespersons licence.

In addition to achieving the course, you must complete a minimum of 500 hours over an 8-month period logging your work with a licenced plumber. Candidates can backdate the tasks before the start date of the block.

Pre Requisites

- Must hold a provisional plumbing licence
- Must have a USI Number (<u>www.usi.gov.au</u>)
- Certified Copy of Offshore Technical Skills Record (OTSR)
- Proof of ID (Driver's License or Passport)
- Copy of White Card
- Be working for an Australian licenced plumber
